The Treaty of Tordesillas was an agreement signed in 1494 in the Spanish town of Tordesillas by Spain and Portugal dividing the non – European world between them. Pope Alexander VI had in 1493 drawn a demarcation line 100 leagues west of the Cape Verde Islands to separate the rival colonial ambitions of these two Catholic powers. This decision gave all the New World to Spain, Asia and Africa to Portugal. The new line of demarcation of 1494 was placed 370 leagues west of the Cape Verde Islands and thus gave Portugal the right to colonize Brazil.
